Field Trip: May 17th & 18th to the Trona Pinnacles & the world famous China Lake petroglyphs. Saturday morning we will meet at Kathy & Woody Minnich's in Little Rock. Woody has graciously volunteered to be our desert guide. He will be leading us through Jawbone & Redrock Canyons to the famous Trona Pinnacles. Along the way we will be stopping to see California cacti such as, *Echinocereus engelmanni*, *E. polycephalus*, *E. triglochidiatus*, *Sclerocactus*, *Opuntia basilaris*, various Agaves, Joshua trees & wildflowers. Saturday night you may wish to spend the night in Ridgecrest & join us for cocktails & dinner. (Some members are staying at Best Western China Lake Inn in Ridgecrest 1-760-371-2300) Sunday, 7:00am, we will meet at the Maturango Museum (in Ridgecrest) for registration & orientation. We will then carpool through the China Lake Naval Weapons Center en route to the petroglyphs. We may be lucky and see some wild mustangs & donkeys. The petroglyphs are the largest & best preserved petroglyphs in the Western hemisphere. There are over 6,000 drawings drawn 16,000 years ago. We will spend 6 hours walking & viewing. You must wear good walking shoes, bring your own food & water, and lots of film. Please see <http://www.maturango.org/pettoursF02.html> for a great deal of info. Also note that there are a few extra restrictions for this trip since we will be on land governed by the U.S. Navy. No children under 10 years old, Everyone must be a U.S. citizen.
